



## Part 4: No Turning Back

### INTRODUCTION

Every single person in their journey of following Jesus will at some point along the way reach a place where they will be tempted to stop following. And those times are going to be, during times of transition. What will happen is you're going to be tempted to unfollow because it's too hard, it's too inconvenient, or it's too costly. And when it occurs, the question you must ask yourself is: *To whom shall I go?*

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

#### AWAKEN

1. Share an experience where you happen to question about the reality of a promise of someone very close to you. What did you feel during that time? What decision have you made after that?
2. Have you ever received a specific promise from the Lord wherein you doubted whether it would happen or not? What made you doubt?

#### ALIGN

3. Read John 6:44-66. What made it hard for the disciples to understand what Jesus was talking about?
4. As a follower of Jesus, what was the hardest or most inconvenient or most costly decision you have made to keep on following Him? Why did you do that? What other options have you considered when you were in that transition?

#### APPLY

5. What specific steps will you make to keep you on track in following Jesus? How can this group help you in implementing those steps?

### MOVING FORWARD

Transition, temptation and trouble create questions. But considering the options brings clarity. When those times come, don't give up right away. Consider all your options and see if there's anything or anyone else worth following and giving your life into. If you quit following now, to whom will you go? If not Jesus then who? If not Christianity then what?
